

DESTINATION

ROSEVILLE, CALIFORNIA

Explore a destination in California that has deep roots in the historic Gold Rush and the railroad. Along the eastern edge of the Sacramento Valley at the base of the majestic Sierra Nevada foothills is Roseville, just 16 miles from Sacramento. What started as a small Gold Rush town has grown into a city of more than 100,000 residents, yet it still has retained a feeling for its roots.

Roseville has preserved its native oaks, wetlands, wildlife habitat and ancient Native American Sites for visitors, so there is plenty of natural beauty to explore. Roseville also offers extensive shopping, from its Galleria Mall to open-air markets, and Denio's, the largest farmers market and auction in Northern California. About a 30-minute drive is Sacramento, where you can tour the state capitol building and explore Old Sacramento – a 28-acre state historic park located downtown along the Sacramento River, with shopping, dining, entertainment, historical attractions and world-renowned museums set within the time of the California Gold Rush and Transcontinental Railroad.

Kaiser Permanente Roseville is the biggest hospital in the area, housed within two hospital buildings and two medical office buildings, all interconnected by a grassy courtyard. Restaurants and shopping are within walking distance of the facility, and bike trails are also accessible. Recognized as one of the “greenest” hospitals in the country, in January 2009, Roseville also opened a 174-bed Women and Children’s Center – the largest of its kind in the area. FOLSOM AND CITRUS HEIGHTS

An excellent choice for travelers working at Kaiser Roseville is [Overlook at Blue Ravine](#) (1200 Creekside Dr., Folsom, CA 95630). Only 10 miles from Kaiser Roseville, the Overlook offers two resort style pools, spa, fitness center, fully furnished club house, tennis courts and direct access to the American river bike trail. All apartments have spacious floor plans, washer and dryer, ceiling fans and private patio. The Overlook is only five minutes from Highway 50 and historic downtown Folsom. Walk to Folsom Lake College, shopping, dining and entertainment establishments. The Overlook offers

a pet friendly community, a private dog park and no weight limit on dogs.

Another great choice is [The Grove at Sunrise in Citrus Heights](#) (5400 Heritage Tree Lane, Citrus Heights, CA 95610), only eight miles from Kaiser Roseville. Units are available with granite countertops, solid wood cabinetry and full-size washers and dryers in every home. Situated on 10 lush acres, The Gove is home to 14 species of trees, including coastal redwoods and southern magnolias.
